



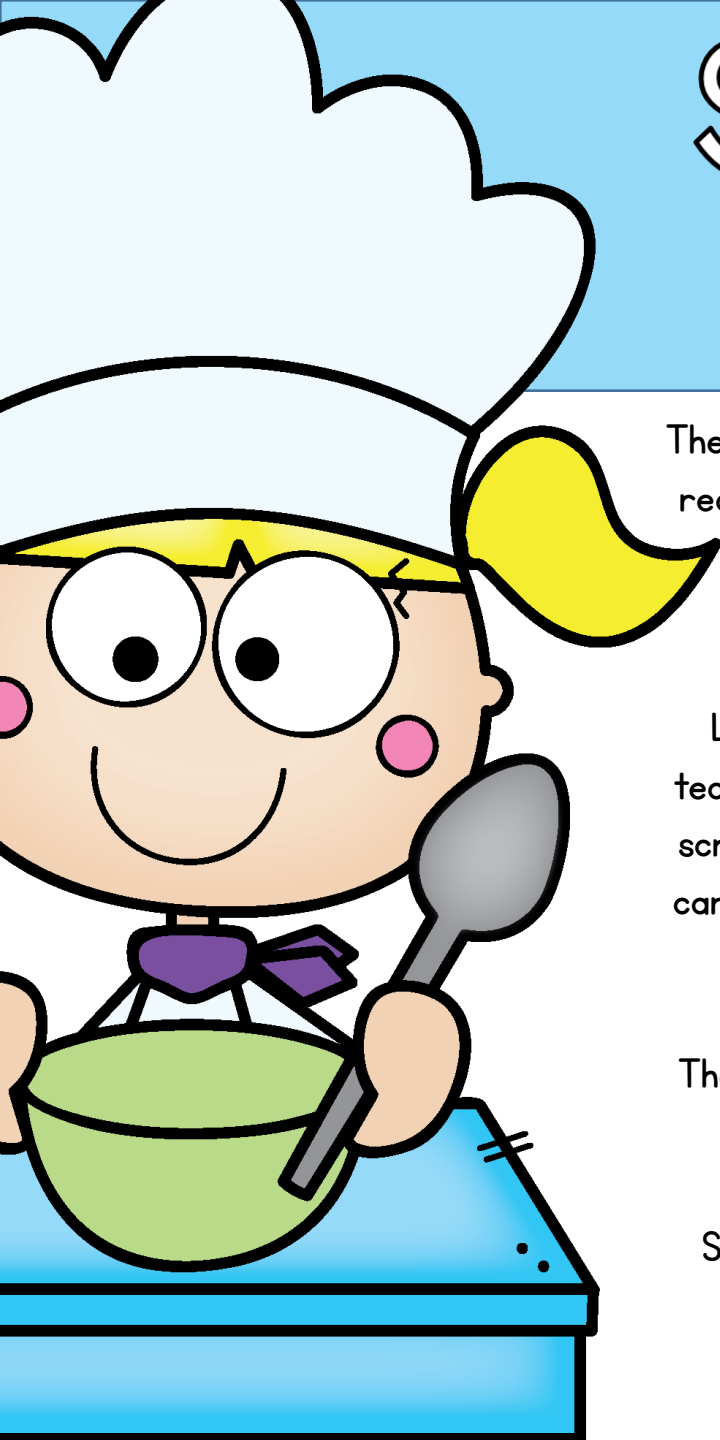

SEGMENTING *Salad*



The Segmenting Salad was created as a game to play in a small group/guided reading setting. This game can be differentiated to play by long and short vowel sounds depending on the needs of your students.

Distribute one “segmenting salad bowl” to each student in the group. Laminate and cut apart the fruit cards and the segmenting cards. The teacher will place the fruit cards in a pile on the teacher table. Shuffle and scramble cards face up. The teacher will read one calling card (segmenting card) aloud. Students will have to blend the sounds together and search for the picture of the word (on the fruit cards) to add to his/her bowl.

The teacher will determine how many different pieces of fruit students will need in their bowls to win (3, 5, 12...etc.) When one student has the determined amount of fruit in his/her bowl, he/she wins the game. Students collect fruit for his/her salad by blending the segmented words together and finding the fruit cards that match.

1 bowl, 10 sets of vowel cards (long and short) are included
